

# Are You Interested in Becoming an AMIAS? (Al-Anon Members Involved in Alateen Service)

### First things first! What is and is not Alateen?

- Part of Al-Anon Family Groups
- A fellowship of young people whose lives have been affected by alcoholism in a family member or close friends
- <u>It is not</u> a program for young people seeking sobriety
- It is not a therapy program

## What are the Requirements to Become a Certified AMIAS in Area 9?

- An Al-Anon member who regularly attends Al-Anon meetings
- At least 21 years of age
- A current member of at least two (2) years in Al-Anon in addition to any time as an active member of Alateen
- An Al-Anon member who has not been convicted of a felony, has not been charged with child abuse or any other inappropriate sexual behavior

### Who Can Train AND Get Certified?

• Qualified Al-Anon members willing to be directly responsible for young members, whether as a chaperone at a one-time event, a driver, a substitute sponsor or a group sponsor.

## What is the Area 9 Alateen Process to Get Trained and Certified?

  your local District 4 Alateen Chair is (position open at this time) and make contact with others in
  your District who are in service to Alateen.
- Download and fill out the AFG Area 9 AMIAS Certification Form (2022), and the VECHS Waiver Form (2022) on our Area 9 website, <u>Alateen Resources - AL-ANON FAMILY GROUPS - AREA 9</u> FLORIDA NORTH (afgarea9.org).
- Register for a F.R.E.S.H. event (<u>Forms</u>, <u>Refreshments</u>, <u>Experience</u>, <u>Strength</u>, and <u>Hope</u>) by emailing our Area 9 Alateen Coordinator, Eleanor J., at <u>alateen-61@afgarea9.org</u>.
